Re: Year 11 Field Study Centre in Snowdonia

We are incredibly excited to offer our Year 10 students studying Geography the opportunity to experience a geography residential experience at the 'FSC (Field Studies Council)' Field Study Centre in Snowdonia - Rhyd-y-creuau. The Drapers Field Centre. The date of this trip will be Friday 14th November to Sunday 16th November 2025.

The purpose of this trip is to help students understand and experience a glacial landscape beyond just looking at one in a textbook. We will also develop fieldwork techniques in this unique landscape to supplement the one-day field days we already do for Human (in Northampton) and Physical (in Hunstanton) Geography. These help with Paper 1 and 3 of their examinations.

The full cost of this trip is £225.00 to be paid on My Child At School. This payment will cover the cost of the transport, food, experienced Fieldwork Instructors, and access to ICT facilities. We only have 12 places for this trip on a first come first served basis. To secure your child's place on this trip we require a £100.00 deposit by Wednesday 29th January 2025. The deposit will become non-refundable when we reach 12 students on or before 29th January 2025.

We intend to leave school promptly at 7.30am on Friday 14th November 2025 and return to Thomas Becket Catholic School on Sunday 16th November by 5.00pm, traffic dependant. Students will be able to take their mobile phones and will be encouraged to make contact with home whilst on route with a more specific ETA.
